

MAINTENANCE OF PARASOLS

Instructions for proper cleaning and storage of items

The acrylic fabric paste-dyed (or solution-dyed) represents the highest quality solution available on the market in terms of color resistance to UV rays and atmospheric agents. To preserve its excellent aesthetic and functional properties over time, regular and careful maintenance is recommended.

Thorough cleaning of the open parasol is indispensable. Use cold or lukewarm water (30–40°C), eventually adding a neutral detergent specifically designed for delicate fabrics. Then rinse thoroughly to remove any soap residue. To remove any stubborn stains, use a soft sponge soaked in water and neutral soap, rinsing thoroughly.


The use of a **low-pressure washer** is permitted only. It is recommended to avoid using the jet at close range as it could cause irreparable damage to the fabric.

After washing, let the parasol dry completely in the open air, ensuring that no traces of humidity remain. Items should only be stored when they are perfectly dry, in a humidity-free and preferably well-ventilated environment.

If using the parasols in **environments with high exposure to salt air**, after washing we recommend as well **the cleaning of the ribs on the upper part** near the cover, using a soft cloth to remove any salt deposits.



It is recommended to wash with cold or lukewarm water. It is possible to use a neutral detergent and rinse thoroughly.





- → solvents and abrasive detergents for cleaning the product
- → alcohol-based cleaners and bleaches.
- → polishing spray.

Ironing at low temperature is permitted, do not use steam.



Make sure the product is completely dry before storing it, to avoid the formation of streaks, mold,, etc.
